- 1 Son of a Methodist minister; he became a Presbyterian, U.S. Senator and Vice-President for President Jimmy Carter
- 3 The only active minister and the only college president to sign the Declaration of Independence
- 4 This Presbyterian elder helped to write the UN Charter, served as Secretary of State for Eisenhower and was an active national Presbyterian lay leader
- 7 Vice-President under Jefferson; he killed Alexander Hamilton in a duel
- 8 A Presbyterian abolitionist martyr for freedom and for freedom of the press
- 11 Only President from Pennsylvania and the only bachelor
- 12 African-American Presbyterian missionary famous for revealing Belgian atrocities in the Congo Free State
- 17 Presbyterian General Assembly Moderator; he wrote "A Letter to Presbyterians" opposing McCarthyism
- 20 Chief Justice of U.S. Supreme Court, 1969-1986
- 21 This President earlier married Barbara Pierce in the First Presbyterian Church in Rye, NY
- 22 First American to orbit the Earth and later a U.S. Senator
- 25 Supreme Justice who argued "our constitution is color-blind" in 1896
- 26 A national Presbyterian leader who spoke before Martin Luther King Jr. gave his "I Have a Dream" speech at the 1963 "March of Washington" rally.
- 28 Secretary of Defense in 1960s who later served as president of the World Bank.

- 4 Presbyterian minister, advanced religious and civil liberty in colonial Virginia that is seen as the basis for religious freedom in the USA
- 5 Three-time Democratic candidate for President; he was later a lawyer against evolution in the Scopes Trial
- 6 A Sunday School teacher who defeated fellow Presbyterian Elizabeth Dole to become a U.S. Senator
- 9 President of Delaware, Signer of the Declaration of Independence, later Chief Justice and Governor of Pennsylvania.
- 10 Current U.S. Senator from Delaware who is married to a Presbyterian elder
- 13 Long-time FBI Director and a Presbyterian Sunday School teacher
- 14 U.S. President during Mexican-American War
- 15 One of the most conservative Senators and leader of the Tea Party movement
- 16 A democratic representative system of church government that influenced the creation of the U.S. Constitution
- 18 Son of a Presbyterian minister, he is the only President to serve two non-consecutive terms
- 19 He attended the Presbyterian Academy, later top Union General in the Civil War and U.S. President
- 23 This 16th President often attended the New York Avenue Presbyterian Church in Washington, but never joined.
- 24 This Presbyterian activist rescued and educated more than 3,000 Chinese slave girls and women during her ministry, in

- 29 The only President to be baptized in office (by a Presbyterian minister); he later promoted the Good News Bible with his photo on its cover
- 30 This Secretary of State for George W. Bush is the daughter and granddaughter of Presbyterian ministers
- 31 A freed slave who was ordained a minister in 1842 and later was U.S. ambassador to Liberia
- 32 She was the head of the American Red

Cross and a former U.S. Senator from NC.

- 1 Senate Chaplain who was portrayed in book/movie "A Man Called Peter"
- 2 Son of a Presbyterian minister; he was longest-serving justice in the history of the Supreme Court
- 3 This President's grandfather, father and father-in-law were all Presbyterian ministers and he was an elder as well as a Nobel Peace Prize winner.

San Francisco, 1895-1934.

- 25 The only President whose grandfather was a president, he married the daughter of a Presbyterian minister
- 27 First Presbyterian to be elected President and was nicknamed "Old Hickory."
