A 30 Year History

The Witherspoon Society was formed in 1973 by a group of Presbyterians who shared a vision that justice should not be sacrificed for unity. Since then, Witherspoon members have been quietly and consistently working toward that vision — at the General Assembly, through local chapters, within congregations, and with personal witness in the world.

The Society continues to articulate this prophetic vision and to build a Whole Gospel community that reflects the reconciling Gospel of Jesus the Christ in a world and a denomination increasingly broken.

Why Belong to Witherspoon?

- ✦ **theology:** Witherspoon seeks to revitalize the church's life and focus, so that it may be biblically and confessionally faithful in the world;
- ✦ **vision:** Witherspoon voices the prophetic vision of an inclusive church in a just society.
- ✦ **scope:** Witherspoon continues to focus on the broad range of justice issues — economic, social, environmental and national.
- ✦ **success:** Witherspoon has been quietly and effectively working for peace, justice and the inclusion of all God's people in the church and the world for 30 years.
- ✦ **program:** Witherspoon has developed a strong educational and theological basis to speak *to* issues of justice and *for* those traditionally not heard; and
- ✦ **commitment:** Witherspoon will advocate for all issues of justice as long as there is injustice. We figure that will keep us busy for a while.

Into the Future - A New Program for the Next 30 Years

Now more than ever, Witherspoon is called to focus on our original goal, the larger vision of justice — national, economic, social, sexual and environmental.

This is a time to build and expand on our witness and work for the new century by:

- ✦ continuing our presence at General Assembly: providing information to Commissioners; sponsoring educational events; honoring congregations and individuals who represent the Whole Gospel message; networking with youth; and of course, dancing!
- ✦ fostering ongoing partnerships with other justice, peace and environmental groups within the PC(USA); and
- ✦ supporting our website and *Network News* to spread the message.

And we're going in ambitious new directions by:

- ✦ adding more local outreach, support and networking to chapters and individuals;
- ✦ sponsoring regional and national meetings to strengthen theological thinking and build connections among progressive Presbyterians;
- ✦ developing our website and other channels to share the progressive viewpoint in the wider church;
- ✦ working with youth and seminary students to engage them in the progressive work of our church; and
- ✦ networking with others for justice in the church and in the world.
